Each Jazz Band will have 5 saxes (2 altos, 2 tenors and 1 bari); 4 trumpets, 4 trombones and a rhythm section of piano, bass guitar and drums. Some parts may be doubled to provide campers with optimal learning experiences.
<b>Jazz Band 4 Advanced</b>	1:30PM	3:00PM	For more advanced jazz musicians. Each Jazz Band will have 5 saxes (2 altos, 2 tenors and 1 bari); 4 trumpets, 4 trombones and a rhythm section of piano, bass guitar and drums. Some parts may be doubled to provide campers with optimal learning experiences.

<b>Vocal Choir (Campers and Guests)</b>	1:30PM	3:00PM	Join other passionate adult singers and experience choral singing in a supportive and friendly environment. <b>Woodwind Chamber Music</b>	1:30PM	3:00PM	For clarinets, saxes, flutes, oboes, bassoons and French horns who would like to play chamber music. Parts will be doubled as needed.
<b>Barbershop Choir (Campers &amp; Guests)</b>	3:30PM	5:00PM	For all singers, campers and music critics, who want to sing unaccompanied barbershop style music.
<b>Brass Ensemble Advanced</b>	3:30PM	5:00PM	Ensemble music for all brass instruments at a more advanced level.
<b>Dixieland Band</b>	3:30PM	5:00PM	Clarinet, Trumpet, T-nor Sax, Trombone, Piano, Bass, Banjo, & Drums. Happy New Orleans styled music that is fun to play.
<b>Jazz Band 1 Beginner</b>	3:30PM	5:00PM	Entry level. This band is for those with limited or entry level jazz experience. Each Jazz Band will have 5 saxes (2 altos, 2 tenors and 1 bari); 4 trumpets, 4 trombones and a rhythm section of piano, bass guitar and drums. Some parts may be doubled to provide campers with optimal learning experiences.
<b>Jazz Band 2 Intermediate</b>	3:30PM	5:00PM	For musicians with some jazz experience. Each Jazz Band will have 5 saxes (2 altos, 2 tenors and 1 bari sax); 4 trumpets, 4 trombones and a rhythm section of piano, bass guitar and drums. Some parts may be doubled to provide campers with optimal learning experiences.
<b>Klezmer Band</b>	3:30PM	5:00PM	For clarinets, saxophones, trumpets or violins, keyboard, trombones, tubas, harmonicas, accordions and percussion. Klezmer music is traditionally dance tunes and music for Jewish weddings and celebrations. ("Jewish Dixieland")
<b>Music Technology</b>	3:30PM	5:00PM	How to use a computer or tablet to organize and store your music, replace paper sheet music, annotate, change pages, create playlists, etc. For hands-on experience bring your own tablet or laptop. As time permits, other software will be discussed, such as IRealPro, Audacity, etc.
<b>Percussion 101 (Campers and Guests)</b>	3:30PM	5:00PM	For campers and music critics. Learn the basics of percussion. How to hold and move the sticks, how to play some of the instruments, and how to look good while counting rests will all be covered. No experience is necessary. Sticks will be provided.
<b>Stroll Band</b>	3:30PM	5:00PM	A stroll band (a concept made popular by Ward Green, one of our instructors) is a group of instrumental musicians who perform well-known music, often wearing goofy outfits that help set a playful mood. The audience is encouraged to participate through singing, clapping. Selected members of the audience help lead the songs we play. Physical aspects of music are emphasized (e.g. YMCA, the Hokey Pokey, the Macarena, Alley Cat, conga line). Ward hopes that campers will enjoy being part of a stroll band and, hopefully, help spread the stroll band movement (pun intended).
